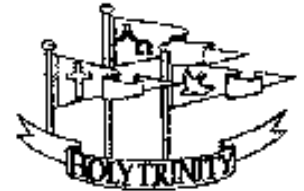

CHRISTMAS PARTY AND NATIVITY - WEDNESDAY 14TH DECEMBER

As Christmas is fast approaching I know some of you would like to know what's going on regarding the Nativity and Christmas Party so you can make sure that you are available. Over the next 2 weeks we will be practising a few songs and selecting children for starring roles in our Nativity. Every child will be dressing up if they wish to (we provide the costumes) and will all play a part in the production. The format of the morning will be as follows:-

- 11am** Children arrive at Pre-school and get prepared for the nativity. Refreshments will be served in the foyer for parents, grandparents etc.
- 11.30am** Nativity play commences in the Worship area. This should last about half hour but allow extra time for photos etc. At the end of the Nativity there will be a retiring collection for 'Mary' a child we sponsor in Kenya (please see attached for further information).
- 12.00pm** Children will return to the Pre-school rooms to get changed and have a story. Parents are free to hang around in the foyer for more refreshments.
- 12.15pm** Children will sit down for party food and a drink.
- 1.15pm** Children to be collected from Pre-school. Father Christmas will not be visiting but we have been assured he will be leaving some gifts for all the children.

As this day is not covered by Nursery Grant funding there will be a charge of £7. Please return the slip attached by Friday 3rd December with your payment if you wish your child to take part. If you are able to make a contribution of food for the party please could you sign up on the noticeboard.

CHRISTMAS CRAFTS

The children will be taking part in some craft activities over the next few weeks. We are keen for them to do as many as they would like to (within reason!) and nobody will come home empty-handed. However, please bear in mind that not all children are as keen to do these activities as others and we will not force any of them to do anything they don't want to. If you wish to discuss this further or indeed would like to join in with any of the activities you would be most welcome.
